### EXPLANATION OF FEES

**APPLICATION PROCESSING FEE: PER STUDENT (Non-refundable)**

The Application Processing Fee is required at the time of application to FBCS. This fee covers some of the costs associated with the application process and any testing that is required. This fee does not apply to current families re-enrolling at FBCS.

**REGISTRATION FEE: PER FAMILY (Non-refundable)**

The Registration Fee is required at the time of re-enrollment for returning families or within 5 days of acceptance to FBCS for new families.

**STUDENT RESOURCE FEE: PER STUDENT (Non-refundable)**

The Student Resource Fee covers most books, student supplies, and classroom teaching supplements. The book portion of this fee is a prorated fee, since some books are consumable and some last more than one year. Students retain consumable books only at the end of the year. If a student withdraws prior to the start of the school year, the resource fee is not refunded and any books or supplies are forfeited.

**CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FEE: PER FAMILY (Non-refundable)**

The Capital Improvements Fee covers the acquisition of new facilities as well as the upgrade and improvement of existing facilities. This fee helps cover expenses like painting, replacement of carpet, repairs to classrooms, etc.

**NEW FAMILY FEE: PER FAMILY (Non-refundable)**

The New Family Fee is a one-time fee payable within 5 days of acceptance to FBCS. This fee is used for the continued development and advancement of FBCS's programs, including the acquisition of new facilities.
